Some interesting news items; There has been a lot of press on the Saddle Ridge Hoard of Gold coins. The mint is again looking into the costs of using Copper-Nickel in coins, as the prices are rising. PCGS graded and authenticated a 1974-D Aluminum Cent which is the first known example. Canada is using a new laser security technique on its' \$50 coin to prevent counterfeiting.

Dave talked about the metal content of the Olympic medals. The Gold Medals are only plated.

Dave reported on recent coin shows. The Cheyenne show was not good. The Longmont show only had a fair turnout.

Dave then reviewed the upcoming shows.

Dave reviewed the Door Prizes, Raffle, and Coin of the Month for this meeting.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes that were in the Newsletter.
