Nebraska passed a state bill to exempt coins from sales tax.

Dave reported on recent coin shows. The Jefferson County show was average. Dave did not attend the Grand Junction show. The Denver Coin Expo was an average show for Dave with good dealer to dealer sales. Attendance was up according to the promoter.
