Some interesting news items; A legal case involving a 1974-D Aluminum Cent had a Judge rule that the owner had failed to prove that they own the coin. An auction sold a \$10,000 Federal Reserve Note for \$117,500. Designs for next years' quarters have been released. The US Mint may mint a Standing Liberty Quarter in 2016 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the original. They may also do a gold version. Dave reviewed the past shows. The Jefferson County show in August was slow. The Longmont show was dead with few customers.

The program was a "Coin Grading Roundtable" hosted by Dave F. and Mark H. Dave and Mark described the process you should use to grade coins including using the proper lighting to view the coins. How to look for luster and luster breaks. The importance of strike, and how marks and nicks affect grade. Many slabbed coins where then passed around to allow the club members to attempt to grade them. The grades on the slabs were covered. Then each coin was discussed and the slabbed grade was revealed. Most coins where Mint state or high AU. This was to try to teach the importance of looking for slight wear and luster breaks.
