

# NORTHSIDE COIN CLUB NEWSLETTER

## September 2009 Issue

The monthly Northside Coin Club meeting will be held on Thursday September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009 at 7 PM (doors open at 6:30) at the Cimarron Village Community Building in Broomfield, see our web site [www.northsidecoinclub.org](http://www.northsidecoinclub.org) for directions. The program for this month will be part 2 of Dave F. presentation on Detecting Counterfeit coins.

**SNACKS** – Joann L. has signed up to bring snacks for the September meeting.

**COIN of the MONTH** – Token or Medal. (If possible a higher grade, nice collector coin, preferably un-circulated).

[The “Coin of the Month” works as follows. Bring one coin, of the type described as the featured coin of the month, preferably in a 2x2 or flip. If you bring a coin, you will get a ticket in the drawing and your coin goes into the pot. We then draw one ticket and the winner gets the entire pot of coins that were featured.

**SHOW and TELL** – bring some interesting item from your collection that you would like to show the members and give a quick (1 minute) talk on.

Last months meeting was held on August 6<sup>th</sup>. 25 members were present including a new member, Walker R., who is our newest Junior member.

**MINUTES** – President Tim Z. called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm.

Tim reviewed the minutes of the last meeting. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes. Michael T. gave the Treasurers report and stated we have \$1102.97 in the club account. Michael stated that this total was the same as in July. A motion was made and seconded to approve the Treasurers report. (Remember that any adult member may see the complete Treasurer’s report by simply requesting to view it at the meeting.) Tim introduced one guest; Tom Oliver.

Theo gave a quick overview of the upcoming coin shows.

Stuart R. reminded members that he has been bringing many back-issues of the previously released Presidential Dollars (Presidents #1-7) as well as 2009 Sacagawea Dollars. He will only do this through the Sept. 2009 meeting, so please see him to purchase any at face value during the Sept. meetings. He also announced that he would be selling off nearly half of the duplicates in his Statehood Quarter collection. He has nearly 40 extra of each state from both mints for all issues to-date, excluding several during 2003-2005. He is offering them to club members to help complete their collections for face value. Many are in AU condition, and some are in MS. Due to their weight, he is asking that club members tell him in advance what they want, and he will bring them to the Sept. meeting. Note that this offer will only last through the Sept. 2009 meeting.

### Old Business

Coin Show – Theo asked about the status of the NSCC holding a Coin Show. No new information on the proposal was available and Tim Z. said he would try to have a board

meeting in August to decide on the issues. (Editors note: No Board meeting was held in August)

#### New Business

Tim Z. announced that he had paid the \$10.00 fee to register the NSCC as a Colorado non-profit. This is required each year by the State of Colorado.

Don K. had a sports medal. It had a 1976 Denver Broncos schedule on one side and an ad for some Scotch Whiskey. There was a small pimple on one side of the medal and an arrow on the other that allowed the Medal to be used as a spinner to see who would buy the next round of drinks.

Steve L. had a Lincoln Medal in Silver. He also had another coin he wanted to know if it had a die clash and passed it around for opinions.

Dave F. had an Anchorage Alaska Token that was Large Cent sized made around 1923 with a gold nugget attached in the center of the token. Most of these you see have the nugget removed.

Tim Z., who likes to collect foreign coins that are mined in the United States, had a US Assay Office holder made in 1976 in the San Francisco mint for Haiti. He also had a ~200 year old MS62 German Ducat from Hamburg dated 1818.

#### **COIN QUIZ**

No coin quiz was given this month. Dave F., the last winner, will give a quiz some time in the coming months.

**PROGRAM** – The program was presented by Dave F. and was a highlight of the 6-hour class he and Bruce Breedlove gave as a mini-seminar during the second week of this years' ANA Summer Seminar.
