The program for this month will be no program as it is time for the end of the year Christmas party pot luck dinner! The NSCC will furnish the main dish and the drinks. All you need to do is bring a side dish, salad, or dessert, along with your appetite. You can even bring your spouse. Santa may be bringing some gifts (coins), so you don't want to miss out on that. There will also be plenty of opportunity to talk coins with fellow members.

<u>SNACKS</u> – No snacks needed this month as we are having a pot luck dinner.

<u>**COIN of the MONTH**</u> – Pot Luck. Bring anything you like. (A nice, no problems, coin that you as a collector would like to have, would be appreciated).

[The "Coin of the Month" works as follows. Bring one coin, of the type described as the featured coin of the month, preferably in a 2x2 or flip. If you bring a coin, you will get a ticket in the drawing and your coin goes into the pot. We then draw one ticket and the winner gets the entire pot of coins that were featured.

<u>SHOW and TELL</u> – bring some interesting item from your collection that you would like to show the members and give a quick (1 minute) talk on.

Last months meeting was held on November 5th. 27 members were present.

<u>MINUTES</u> – President Tim Z. called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Michael T. gave the Treasurers report and stated we have \$960.19 in the club account. A motion was made and seconded to approve the Treasurers report. (Remember that any adult member may see the complete Treasurer's report by simply requesting to view it at the meeting.)

The upcoming coin shows were reviewed.

Old Business

Dave F. reminded the club of the collection that the club has been asked to evaluate and sell. Dave gave a quick talk on what type of material was in the collection based on what he has examined so far. The club discussed what they might like to do as far as selling the collection. Details on what will be done; will be discussed by the Board at the next Board meeting. (Secretaries note: a Board meeting was held on Nov. 10th)

New Business

Don K. discussed a program he is trying to initiate for the Junior members. The program involves the Juniors doing research on an unknown item that Don provides them with and giving a report to the club members. The first reports will be due in January.

Steve L. gave a presentation on what he is doing through his 7th Day Adventist church and its kids in the Pathfinders merit badge program. Steve is leading a class on coin collecting and a couple of the projects the kids are doing are: collecting a simple 20th Century Type Set, and collecting Foreign Coins. Steve would like some help from the clubs membership to provide some of the coins the kids need to complete their collections. He hopes to have one or two of the kids come and give presentations to the club on what they did, early next year.

Elections – Nominations to fill the seats that will become vacant were opened. The positions needed are President, Secretary, and 1 Director. Dave F. was nominated and seconded for President. Mark H. said he was willing to continue on as Secretary but has not yet been nominated. Members were asked to contact a current Board member via email with any nominations they had before the December meeting.

SHOW & TELL

Dave F. had a case of coins that included Trade Dollars, Seated Dollars, a \$1 gold piece, a Morgan dollar, a racketeer nickel, and a \$3 gold piece. All the coins are counterfeit with the \$3 gold piece having been called both genuine and counterfeit by various experts.

COIN QUIZ

No coin quiz was given this month. Dave F., the last winner, will give a quiz some time in the coming months.

PROGRAM – The program was presented by Leonard Lashaway on "Collecting Paper Money". Leonard is a member of the Front Range Coin Club and started collecting in 1960 when a classmate had a blue Whitman coin album on the school bus and he was fascinated with it. He joined the ANA in 1975 and moved to Colorado in 1979.

Leonard gave an overview of the various categories of what you could collect in the Paper Money field. These included Colonial notes, Continental notes, State Chartered Bank notes, private Bank notes, Fractional currency, National Bank notes, Confederate currency, US currency by both large and small sizes, Military Payment certificates, and Foreign paper money. Leonard also had some examples of many of these from his personal collection. He said another reason to collect Paper Money is due to the artwork on the money.

The "Coin of the Month", which was Silver (War time) Jefferson Nickel, consisting of a pot of 3 coins, was won by Steve L.

Door prizes and Raffle winners were; The Door prize: A 1990 Proof Set, was won by Terry S. The Raffle prize: A 1942 P War time Jefferson Nickel slabbed MS67 by NGC was won by Dave We. That was the second month in a row for Dave!

No Auction was held following the meeting.
