It was a Mexican Coin dated 1957 and was in VF condition. Mexico is south of the Colorado and is part of Central America. The Obverse of the coin had an Eagle, a Snake, and a Cactus on it. The coin is a type of Peso and a Peso is the Mexican unit of currency. Coins like this one were minted from 1957 to 1967. The coin has an indication of fineness on it indicating the silver content. Andrew said he keeps the coin in a locked box in his room to keep it safe. He also said that if he had 2 of them he would trade it for a better one or another coin that he needed.

Dave F. had two counterfeit Walking Liberty Half dollars.

Wayne W. had a 1921 Peace Dollar he picked up when he was 11 at a local coin show. He got it because it has a dimple on the hairline near the center of the coin.
