December 2010 Issue

The monthly Northside Coin Club meeting for December has been CANCELLED!

Due to scheduling conflicts for the meeting facility, the regularly scheduled December meeting will have to be cancelled. Theo G. gave a quick talk on the CWNA (Colorado-Wyoming Numismatic Association) and indicated that he had a petition to nominate 2 people for the upcoming elections and was looking for CWNA members to sign it.

Old Business

Dave F. indicated that he paid fees for the club domain name for the WEB site.

There is no news on a new meeting place.

No new information on donating money to the CWNA scholarship program.

Dave F. reviewed the results of the Auction of the collection of the lady that he and other club members had been working with. Dave indicated that \$49,782 was made from the auction and that there was \$54 in buyers fees that would go into the club treasury. He also indicated that the lady would also be giving us some additional money for our time. Dave also indicated that there would be a part 2 of the Auction sometime early next year.

Dave brought up the topic of the upcoming club elections. Rich M. was nominated for a Director position. Kerry H. was nominated for the Vice President position. We could still use additional nominations for these positions along with a nomination for Treasurer. If

you would like to make a nomination, email the Secretary or any current Board member. (See the table at the end of the newsletter for what positions will need to be filled.) Dave Wi. indicated he would be willing to run again at the October meeting so he is also a current nominee.
