ANA NEWS – Beth Deisher and Alan Herbert were inducted into the Numismatic Hall of Fame during the American Numismatic Association's World's Fair of Money. Herbert, who died in January at the age of 86, was on the ANA Board of Governors in 1999 and from 2003-2008, and wrote monthly columns for various numismatic publications.

Minutes, Notes, and Happening of last months’ meeting

Last month’s meeting was held on September 10th. We had 18 members and one guest in attendance. The guest, Bob C. ended up becoming a club member by joining later in the evening.

President Dave F., called the meeting to order at 7:03.

Dave introduced our guest Bob C. Bob had visited our club before. He said he was currently working part time at Tebo’s Coin shop in Boulder and indicated that they had some other part time openings.

Dave reminded the club members that there were old copies of various coin magazines and papers to borrow. He then related a few stories from Coin World. The US House of Representatives OK’d a Bill to expand the Hobby Protection Act. A 1793 Chain Cent, graded MS69 Brown by PCGS, the highest ever graded Chain Cent, was going to be in an ANA Auction.

Locally, Jerry Morgan, owner of the Denver Coin Expo, has sold his coin show to Jaben Broach, the owner of CollecTons in Boulder. Jaben will take over starting with the May 2014 show. Chuck Hayes has been named as the person who will run the show.

Member Denny W. passed on some information that NGC is doing some conservation of coins when they are submitted for grading without permission of the coin’s owner.

Dave reported on recent coin shows. Dave F. indicated that the Jefferson County show had fewer dealers than normal, and average attendance. He had no information on the Cheyenne Wyoming show, and wasn’t even sure if it had been held. There was some confusion on the date.

Dave We. reviewed the upcoming coin shows.

Dave reviewed the Door Prizes, Raffle, and Coin of the Month for this meeting.

Steve L. indicated that the new Ft. McHenry Quarter had been released but he did not have any yet. He did have the Teddy Roosevelt, and Taft dollars.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes that were in the Newsletter.
