On Ebay, a 1788 Vermont Copper in AG, was noticed by some eagle eyes as a rare variety, with only 6 known, and was bid up from a starting price of 99 cents to a final price of \$29,900.

Dave reviewed the Door Prizes, Raffle, and Coin of the Month for this meeting.
