## Minutes, Notes, and Happening of last months' meeting

Last month's meeting was held on Tuesday July 8<sup>th</sup>. We had 16 members in attendance and one guest, Bob Oatman, who was looking to sell his collection.

President Dave F. called the meeting to order at 7:04.

Dave had various coin magazines, papers, and Greysheets to borrow this month.

Some interesting news items; A 1943 Bronze Lincoln Cent sold for \$329,000 at auction. A Colorado man found a 1969-S Double Die in change. It was graded XF45 by ANACS. More legal battles over a recently discovered 1974-D Aluminum Cent. The Government is trying to get it, saying it was never released.

Similar type case as the 1933 \$20 Gold Double Eagle pieces. An ancient Greek Tetradrachm Coin sold for \$3 Million in auction and a Brutus Denarius sold for \$500,000 in a Goldberg auction.

Dave reported on the Colorado Springs show. He felt it was not that good. It was too long and sales were slow.

Michael T. talked about the soon to be released 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Kennedy Half dollars. There will be a total of 7 different versions.

Dave reviewed the Door Prizes, Raffle, and Coin of the Month for this meeting.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes that were in the Newsletter.

## Program

The program was "Cameo Proof Coins from 1950-1964" by Dan Eicher. Dan brought his entire proof coin collection of slabbed Cameo Proof coins, that was housed in a custom Lucite holder that was quite large.

Dan defined what a Cameo Proof coin should look like and also what an Ultra Cameo Proof looks like. He talked about how the Proof dies were prepared and how the coins were minted and why there are few Cameo and Ultra Cameo Proofs from the 50s and early 60s.
