The program was "Vintage Counterfeit Morgan Dollars" by Dan Carr. Dan gave an excellent program on Counterfeit Morgan Dollars of specific dates that were, at one time, thought to be genuine. Over time and much research these have been determined to be excellent fakes. Currently all these Vintage fakes are "O" mint dollars with dates of 1896, 1900, 1901, & 1902. Dan gave information on how each of these coins can be determined to be counterfeit. There is actually a market for these coins and some sell for many thousands of dollars.
