Minutes, Notes, and Happenings of last months' meeting

Last month's meeting was held on Tuesday January 12th. We had 13 members in attendance along with a guest, Rick Parker.

We had one guest, Rick, who found out about us via our website. Rick collects foreign coins.

There were coin magazines, Coin World's, and Greysheets to borrow this month.

Dave reviewed some interesting articles.

- The Chinese Panda Silver coins changed in weight from 1 ounce to 30 grams as they went metric.
- 2016 is the last year for the Presidential Dollars, and there will only be 3 this year.
- -This is the Centennial year for the Mercury dime, Standing Liberty quarter, and Walking Liberty Half dollar. There are plans to make them in gold to commemorate them.
- The Greysheet has been sold to a group led by a Dave Lawrence group. They are making changes such as updating pricing, adding grades, eliminating the Ask price and only having Bid pricing.

Dave reviewed the past coin shows. There were no shows in December.

Dave then reported on upcoming Coin Shows.

Dave reviewed the Door Prizes, Raffle, and Coin of the Month for this meeting.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes that were in the Newsletter.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the Treasurers reports. We currently have \$2836.67 in the club account. (Remember that any adult member may see the complete Treasurer's report by simply requesting to view it at the meeting.)
