The program in October was “Hands on Grading Exercise” by club member Michael S. Michael gave a presentation on grading and talked about what are the differences between Technical grading and Market grading. He discussed the aspects of grading such as Luster, Marks, Strike, Wear, Special Strike Characteristics, and Damage. He described how the Third Party Grading services use Market grading. He then allowed club members to view about a half dozen Morgan dollars that all had been graded with the same grade so they could see how different coins that are graded the same can be.

# President's Notes

Northside Coin Club Meeting November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020

## News Items

1. **Britain's Royal Mint to extract gold from discarded electronics**, Reuters, October 19, 2021. Britain's Royal Mint plans to build a plant in Wales that could reclaim hundreds of kilograms of gold and other precious metals from electronic waste such as mobile phones and laptops. Gold and silver are highly conductive and small quantities are embedded in circuit boards and other hardware, along with other precious metals. Most of this material is never recovered, with discarded electronics often dumped in landfill or incinerated. They have partnered with a Canadian start-up called Excir which has developed chemical solutions to extract the metals from the circuit boards. "It's able to selectively pull out precious metals with a high degree of purity," said Sean Millard, the mint's chief growth officer.

2. **2021 American Eagle gold bullion coin struck with Mint marked die**, Coin World, October 29, 2021. Professional Coin Grading Service has graded and encapsulated 61 2021 American Eagle, Reverse of 2021 quarter-ounce gold bullion coins that the grading service determined were struck at the West Point Mint with unfinished Proof obverse dies bearing the production facility's W Mint mark. While Proof American Eagles bear the Mint mark of production origin, the bullion issues are not intended to bear a Mint mark. The 61 coins were discovered by numismatist Gerald Medel from Lakeside Coins in San Diego, California, from coins he and fellow numismatist Todd Pollock from BluCC Photos in Sacramento, California, secured from multiple sources. Forty of the 61 coins were yielded from a single tube of coins. Ten of the 61 coins were consigned to the online auction firm GreatCollections, with five coins closing on Oct. 31 and the other five closing on Nov. 7.

3. **2021 Morgan and Peace dollars now shipping**, Coin World, October 22, 2021. The U.S. Mint began shipping orders Oct. 18 of the limited-edition 2021 Morgan and Peace dollars struck at three different production facilities. Collectors began reporting Oct. 18 on the Collectors Universe U.S. Coins Forum online that they received notification that orders they had placed for the silver dollars were being processed, credit cards charged and coins readied for shipping.

#### **Please adhere to the following Covid guidelines:**

1. Each group will need a point person for their group. Their responsibilities include:
  - a. Making a list and contact information for each group member in attendance (Optional)
  - b. Making sure the group adheres to the covid protocols below.
  - c. Making sure the room is left in the same condition as found.
2. Masks are optional for vaccinated people.  
However, it is still best practice to wear masks all the time.
3. Open windows when weather permits and turn on furnace fans to help circulate air. When leaving the room, please close windows and turn off fans. If using Fellowship Hall - Please close doors when you leave.
4. Cleaning Protocols: Each group is responsible for cleaning your space after use. This helps with our janitorial services.
  - a. You will find a cleaning bucket and spray bottle in each room.
