### Last Months' Show and Tell Recap

He also had 3 Turtle coins, the first from Fiji dated 2018 and graded PR68 DCAM, the second was from Malaysia graded PR69 DCAM, and the third, a 1 oz. silver Galapagos turtle shaped turtle coin from the Solomon Islands.

### Program

The program in November was "Hidden Images on Banknotes" by club member Bob C. Bob presented many different notes. One note was the famous 1922 German Vampire Note, when turned sideways, you can make out a vampire sucking on the neck of the person who appears on the note. On the 1968 Queen Series Notes, the 10 Rupee banknote has the word SCUM hidden among the corals on the left side of the note. The 50 Rupee banknote has the word SEX in the palm tree leaves. In 1938, the China 1 Yuan Flying Dragon Confucius note shows an image of a finger though a hole made by the other fingers. The 1942 100 Yuan Wolf note depicts wolf heads around the notes' borders. Bob also showed how many notes have images that can only be see under a Black Light. These images are used as anti-counterfeiting measures.

### **Building Usage Agreement COVID Addendum**

We welcome people back to our building. The following is our covid protocols that we ask that you follow and respect. Each group will need to contact the office administrator who will assign the room that will fulfill the needs of your group to the best of our ability. Thank you for being a part of our community.

#### **Please adhere to the following Covid guidelines:**

1. Each group will need a point person for their group. Their responsibilities include:
  - a. Making a list and contact information for each group member in attendance (Optional)
  - b. Making sure the group adheres to the covid protocols below.
  - c. Making sure the room is left in the same condition as found.
  
2. Masks are optional for vaccinated people.  
However, it is still best practice to wear masks all the time.
  
3. Open windows when weather permits and turn on furnace fans to help circulate air. When leaving the room, please close windows and turn off fans. If using Fellowship Hall - Please close doors when you leave.
  
4. Cleaning Protocols: Each group is responsible for cleaning your space after use. This helps with our janitorial services.
  - a. You will find a cleaning bucket and spray bottle in each room.
  - b. Cleaning Instructions are on the bucket
  - c. Return the bucket and spray bottle to the original space.
  - d. Please leave the room in the way that you found it.
  
5. Bathrooms in the main area are limited to one person at a time. Please take note of the vacancy / occupied sign outside each bathroom.

The preschool hallway and area are off limits Monday - Thursday 8:00 a.m. - 2 p.m. People are not allowed in these areas. If a group member needs to visit the office during this time, they need to exit the building and walk around on the outside and go to the office door.
