Program

The program in November was "Did This Coin Cross to PCGS?" by Bob C. Bob car presented the members with 19 coins that had their slab information covered. These had been sent to PCGS to cross from the current slab to a PCGS slab. Nine of the coins crossed and 10 did not. The real purpose of the presentation was to try and determine why the 10 coins did not cross. Reasons ranged from, coin had been cleaned, there was damage on the coin that the original TPG missed, the grade was lower, in PCGS's opinion, than the original TPG had graded it, or the coin did not meet PCGS standards for a additional attribute such as Full Bell Lines (FBL).
